Please join the Planning Commission and biologists from AMEC and the Washington State Department of Ecology on walking tours of the Skykomish River and Maloney Creek. The walks are being organized as part of the Town's update of its Shoreline Master Program.

There will be ongoing discussions of the river, creek and their shorelines. The scientists will share their insight and describe important aspects of the riverine environment while also looking for input and local knowledge from students and townsfolk. They will speak to the type of functions that this type of riverine ecosystem provides, the processes that influence that system and the type of impairments that alter these functions and processes and potential restoration actions.

Skykomish River Walk

The River Walk will be September 24 at 4:30. We'll meet at the west end of River Drive. The River Walk will be limited to the south side of the river, west of 4th St and we may also venture down to the Town's property at the east end of Railroad Ave between the RR and the River. Stephen Stanley of Ecology will lead the River Walk along with Cleve Steward of AMEC.

Maloney Creek Walk

The Creek Walk will include participation from Junior and Senior High School students. The Creek Walk will take place Oct 1st at 12:15 and be completed before 2:15 so the students can catch their buses. We'll enter the creek at Thelma St near the post office and provided we still don't have any water in the creek, we'll walk all the way to the River. Cleve Steward of AMEC will lead the Creek Walk.
